Accomplishments This Year

- **2,926 volunteer hours**
- **7,833 trees, shrubs and groundcover planted**
- **30 group events, plus individual work by Forest Stewards**
- **14 active restoration sites**
- **10 Forest Stewards in 6 parks**
- **48 new acres in restoration at Bear and Evans Creek Greenway, Bear Creek Park, Farrel-McWhirter Park, Grass Lawn Park, Hartman Park, Idylwood Beach Park, Perrigo Park, Redmond West Wetlands, Viewpoint Park, Viewpoint Open Space, the Watershed Preserve, and Westside Park**

- **\$3,000 donation by Whole Foods Market as part of their 5% day in September**
